Powder coating offers an advanced finishing process for a wide range of parts, materials and products used by institutions and everyday consumers seeking a decorative and highly durable finish that will protect valuable assets from heat, cold, grime, scratching, corrosion, bleaching and all forms of weathering.

ELECTRO-STATIC ADVANTAGE

SUNDIAL uses a proprietary powder, mixing finely ground particles of colored pigment and resin. The electrically-charged powder adheres to the metal or aluminum surface being coated. Oven curing the coated part or product causes the charged powder particles to bond to the electrically grounded surface until heated and fused forming a uniform, highly durable finish.

7-STAGE COMMITMENT

SUNDIAL's commitment to quality and innovation sparked the introduction of the first 7-stage pre-treatment wash process in Southern California where parts, materials and products are subjected to a one-of-a-kind, intense cleansing that results in a super-clean substrate and unmatched finished surface quality.

Environment Friendly CONSUMER POWDER COATINGS

SUNDIAL's powder coating process is environmentally friendly and virtually pollution-free. Unlike the liquid paint used in a typical spray painting scenario, no solvents are used in our powder coating process. This means only negligible amounts of volatile organic compounds (VOC's), if any, get released into the atmosphere during powder coating.



- Contains little or no VOC's or volatile organic compounds
- Contains no known carcinogens like spray paint
- Powder coating is virtually pollution-free
- Oversprayed powder is captured not released into the environment

Powder Coating is a smarter, more economical way to apply a decorative and protective finish to metal and aluminum products. It's not just a useful alternative for metal doors and frames, roofing or wrought iron; it's also far superior in terms of coating quality and durability. A popular refinishing method, it's been championed by institutions, homeowners and consumers for courtyard, patio and office furniture, entry gates, barbecue grills, basketball frames, and other interior and exterior furniture, fixtures and recreational items.

Powder Coating uses a uniquely different type of powder than aerosol spray paint. Spray paint, applied as a fine mist, is an expensive process over the long run as it tends to chip and fade quickly often requiring repeated applications. Further, spray painting does not protect the metal or aluminum and often the product is discarded requiring a new purchase. A powder coated surface can last up to 20 years. Clearly, choosing powder coating can save you thousands.
